## RV MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST



## **BEFORE EVERY TRIP** Check tire pressure and condition (including spare) Inspect frame and suspension Test all exterior and interior lights Inspect propane tanks and connections Check fluid levels (engine, hydraulic, brake, etc) Check brakes and brake lights Verify safety equipment (fire extinguisher, CO detector, etc) Inspect the exterior Inspect the interior WEEKLY / EVERY 300-500 MILES Inspect tires for wear, cracks, or damage Check and top off fluid levels Test battery voltage and clean terminals if needed Check slide-outs and awnings for smooth operation Inspect roof and exterior seals for cracks and damage Clean and sanitize fresh water system if used frequently

## **MONTHLY** Wash and wax exterior Inspect and lubricate slide-out seals and mechanisms Sanitize fresh water system Check water pump operation and check plumbing for leaks Test smoke, carbon monoxide, and LP gas detectors Inspect shore power cord and power converter Clean furnace and AC filters Inspect tires and wheel bearings for wear **EVERY 3-6 MONTHS** Inspect roof thoroughly; clean and reseal as necessary Drain and flush water heater, check for leaks and corrosion Inspect holding tanks; clean vents and apply treatments Lubricate chassis components, hinges, and locks Inspect belts, hoses, and exhaust (motorized RV) Perform generator maintenance (Oil change, air filter, spark plugs) Clean and inspect appliances Inspect underbelly, frame, and suspension

## **ANNUAL**

Inspect roof thoroughly; clean and reseal as necessary
Drain and flush water heater, check for leaks and corrosion
Inspect holding tanks; clean vents and apply treatments
Lubricate chassis components, hinges, and locks
Inspect belts, hoses, and exhaust (motorized RV)
Perform generator maintenance (Oil change, air filter, spark plugs)
Clean and inspect appliances
Inspect underbelly, frame, and suspension
